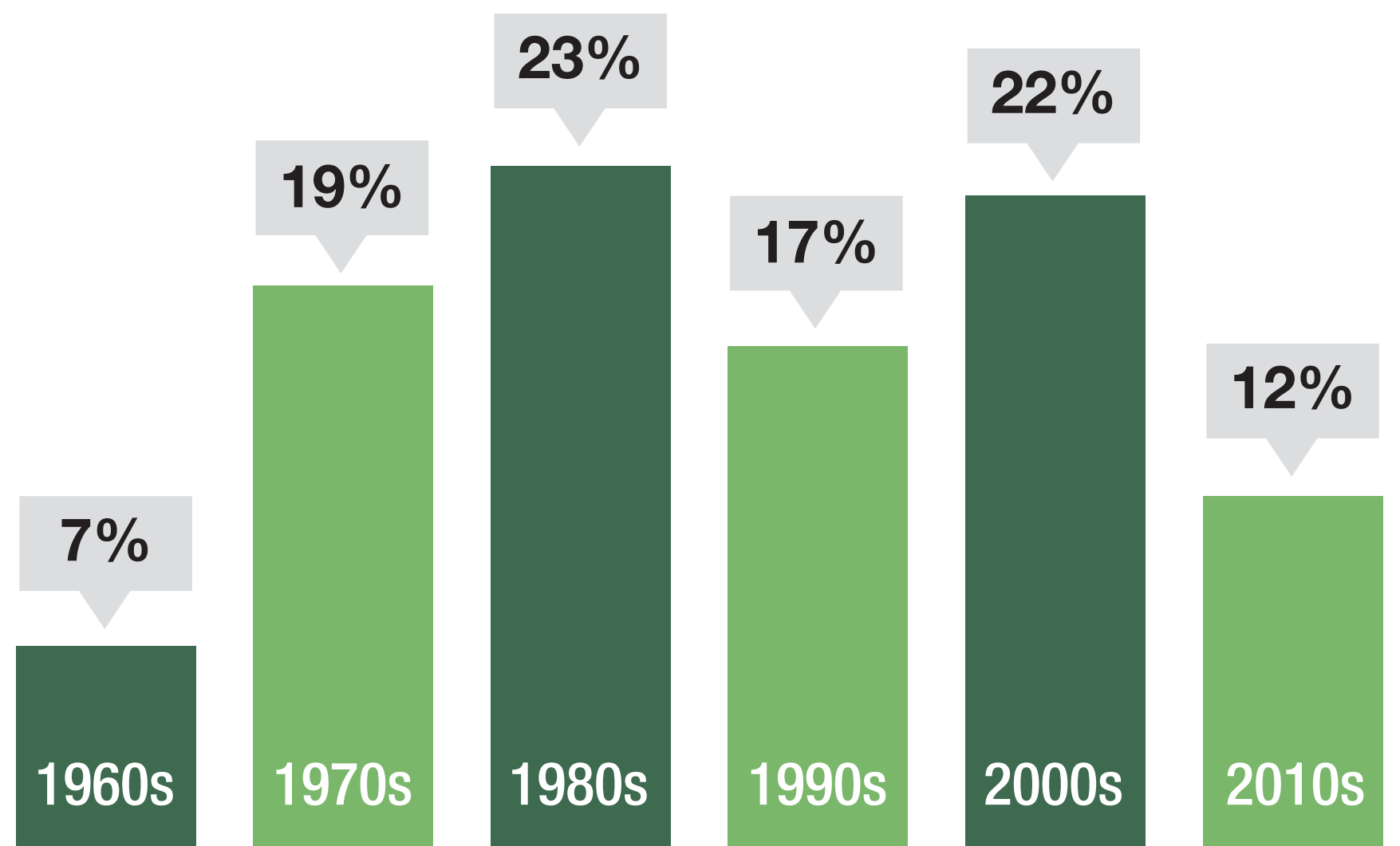

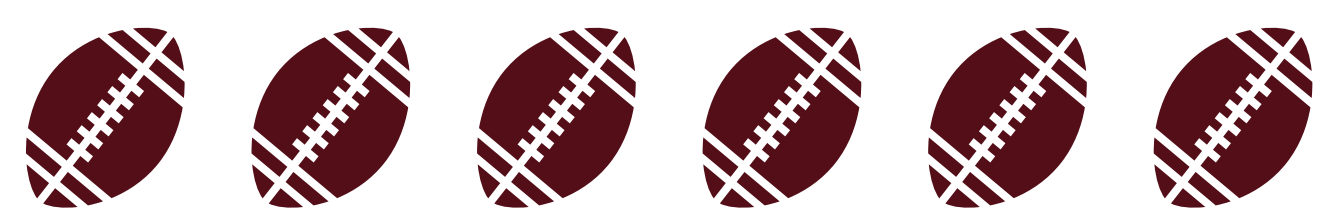

RESPONDENTS' LAST YEAR IN NFL

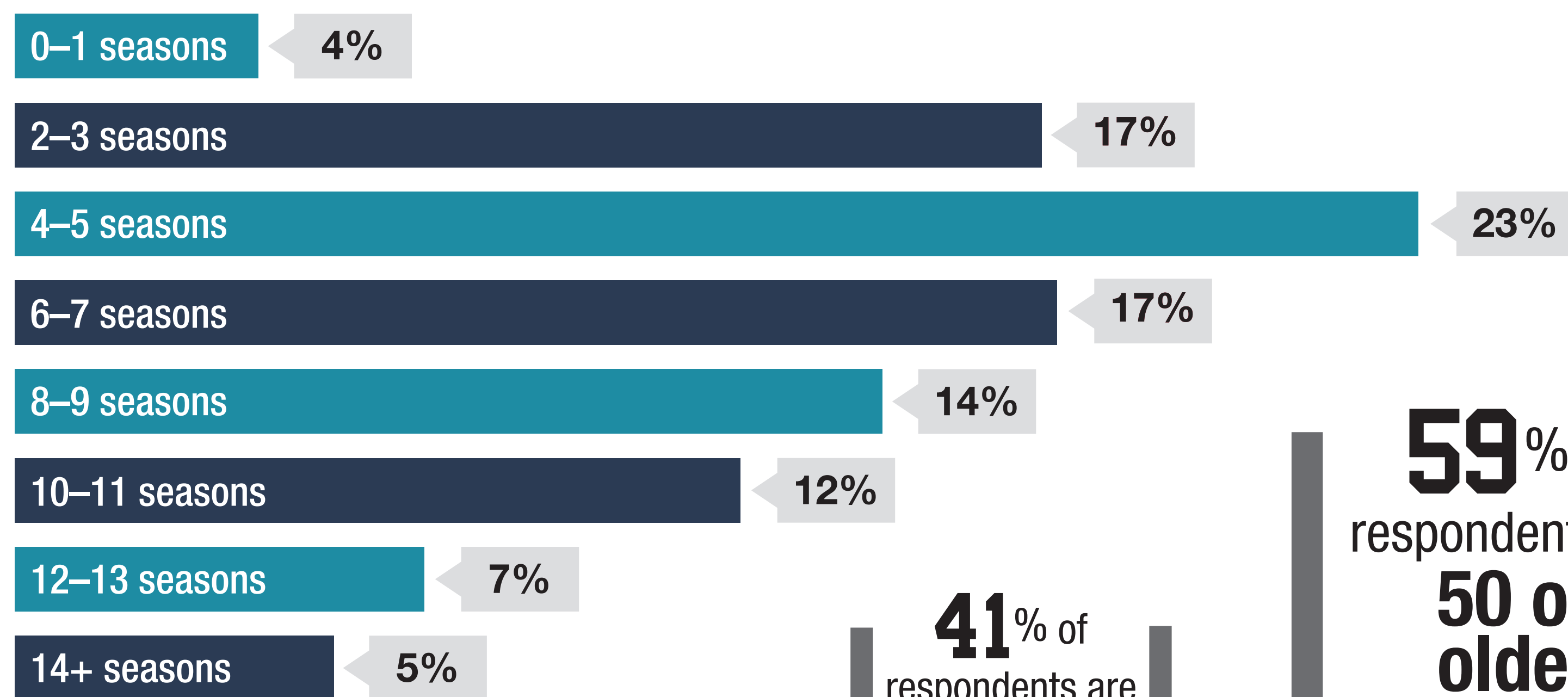
The highest number of respondents left the NFL in the **1980s** followed closely by the **2000s**

AGE OF RESPONDENTS

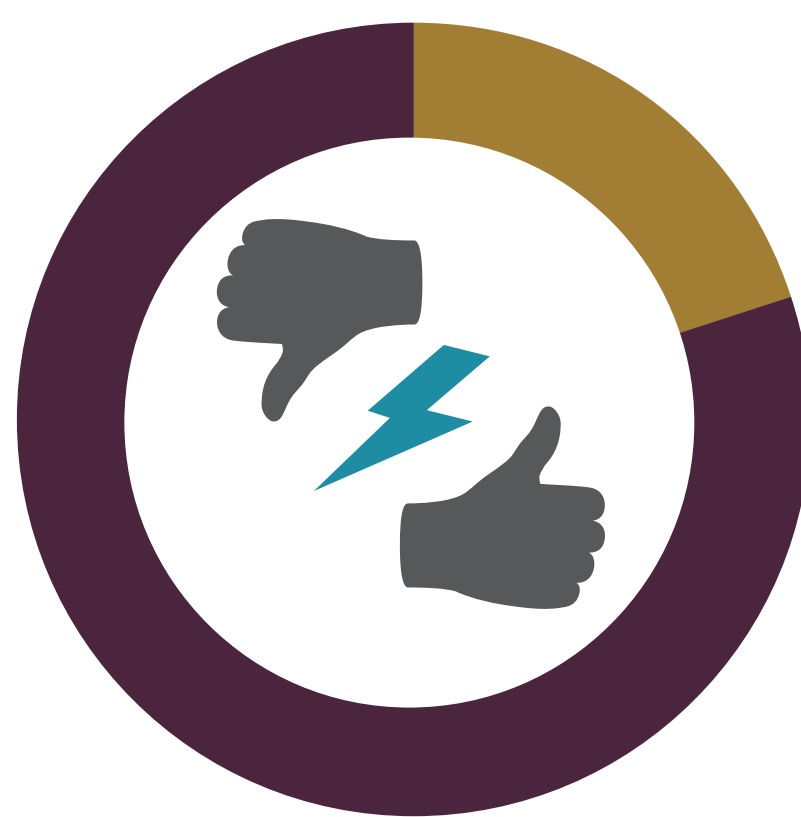


DAILY LIFE OF RESPONDENTS
